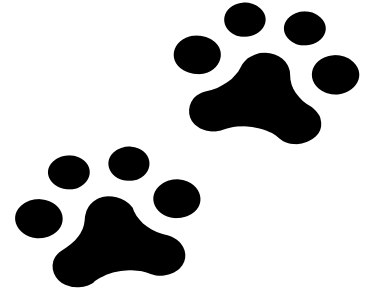

Borah High School and Hillcrest Elementary Schools are proud to announce the implementation of the **Lunch Buddy Program** between the two schools. We currently have over 75 elementary students paired with approximately 60 Borah High School Students.

The Lunch Buddy Program connects a caring adult with an elementary student who needs a positive role model in his/her life. High School volunteers commit to eat lunch with this student during Borah High School collaboration days which extend through the lunch period. After lunch they may read a book, play a board game or just talk. The one-on-one relationship which develops between lunch buddies often makes a profound difference in a child's life.

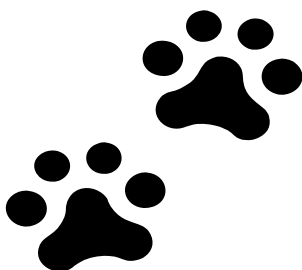

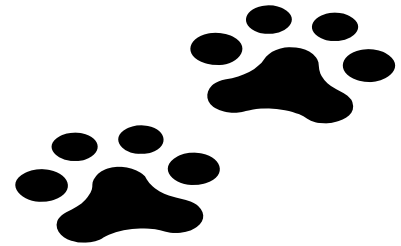
MLK CIVIL RIGHTS COMMEMORATIVE MARCH/RALLY

FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEAL APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED ALL SCHOOL YEAR

Boise School District continues to accept 2009-2010 Free and Reduced Price Meal Applications through the end of the school year. If a household has had a decrease in income and was previously denied benefits, a new application can be submitted.

Application forms are available at all Boise School District schools, the Food & Nutrition Services Office at the District Service Center or on-line at www.boiseschools.org/food. To apply for free or reduced price meals, households should complete an application through the on-line process or fill out an application and return it to the school or District Service Center. A reminder, only one application is needed per family and a new application is needed each school year.

The information provided by the household is confidential and will be used for the purpose of determining eligibility for meal benefits. The information gathered is also very important in assisting in the determination of eligibility for District Title 1 funding.
